- Activity: Role-playing a crisis scenario and leading a response team.

### Day 5: Recovery and Continuous Improvement

- Developing a recovery plan: Restoring operations and supporting affected stakeholders.
- Conducting post-crisis evaluations and identifying lessons learned.
- Updating emergency response plans based on feedback and new risks.
- Course wrap-up: Key takeaways and action plans for continued improvement.
